Burt Dubrow, multiple Emmy and Cable Ace award winning producer, befriended Paul Winchell and got to know the man more deeply than most. Today, Burt is the premiere Paul Winchell historian. During his session, Burt will give you a whole new appreciation of television, of puppetry, of ventriloquism, and of the artistry of Paul Winchell.

One addition this year, is that we'll be adding an extra night of general open mic to allow more people to get additional stage time or experience what it's like to be on stage as a ventriloquist.

Also, for the first time, we'll be introducing vent round table coaching. An opportunity for vents to get one-on-one feedback from seasoned practitioners. Our goal is to help you leave a better ventriloquist than you came. I could write all day about the amazing stuff we have going on this year. Surprise guests, incredible shows and a positively power packed event guaranteed to have you pleased you ever picked up a puppet.

This will be a historic four days of connection, education and entertainment and you don't want to miss being part of it. A chance to reconnect, learn, laugh and grow. JUNIOR/SENIOR OPEN MIC INFO

- Each category will have 8 participants, with two alternates in each division. To apply for one of the eight spots the attendee must email the Executive Director at jimmy@ventconvention.com on March 8, 2024 by 10 AM Eastern Standard Time in the United States. The first 8 messages the Executive Director receives at 10 AM requesting entrance in the respective Open Mic session will be accepted, with two alternates also being accepted. The order of the lists will be determined by the way they are received in the Executive Director's email inbox.
- The time limit will be 5 minutes for a routine.
- After the performer completes his or her routine they will be led to the front of the stage by the MC to receive their comments.
- We will have three critique officials review each performance and all three officials will give the performer comments for improvement and encouragement. A spot up front will be provided for the performer's designated videographer or camera person to record ONLY that person's performance and comments. Immediately after this performer has received his or her comments, the video person must vacate the designated seat for the next performer's video person.
- A ballot for a "People's Choice Award" will be given to each person ATTENDING the open mic session to vote for their top TWO favorites in each division. These ballots will be given out at the door and will be turned in to the Hospitality people who will be collecting the ballots. You cannot leave and then return to the session with your ballot. The ballots will be tallied by the critique officials.
- The first and second place winners in each division will a special award and all participants will be given a "Certificate of Participation".
- ANY campaigning beforehand will result in the participant in question being disqualified from winning.



ConUENTion Location

The Vent Haven ConVENTion site is at the Holiday Inn Cincinnati Airport, 1717 Airport Exchange Blvd, Erlanger, KY 41018

TO REGISTER FOR YOUR ROOM: To be eligible to get a room at our special rate of \$120.00 plus tax per night at the Holiday Inn Cincinnati Airport, you must first be fully registered for the ConVENTion. You can either mail in the registration, along with the fees, or go to venthavenconvention.com and register electronically. After we receive payment we will send you a confirmation email that will give you a passkey code. The room reservations are being handled by the Northern Kentucky Visitor and Convention Bureau. and makes sure you will be in the main hotel instead of an overflow hotel.

Dealers' Rooms

Vent Haven ConVENTion 2024 is pleased to announce that we will again have TWO full Dealers' Rooms available with over 25 Vent Dealers on hand. The two rooms are located on each end of the International Ball Room: Rooms V and VI and Rooms I and II.

Driving/Flight Information

The ConVENTion site (Holiday Inn Cincinnati Airport) is located in Northern Kentucky, just eight miles south of Cincinnati, Ohio. If you're driving up from the south, take I-75 North and then take I-275 West for one mile. Then Exit 2 to the hotel. From the north, take I-75 South until you get to I-275 West, go west one mile and take Exit 2. The nearest airport is the Greater Cincinnati / Northern Kentucky International Airport. (Shuttle Phone 859-371-2233) The hotel is three miles away and offers a free shuttle service to and from the airport.

GENERAL OPEN MICS: To give more people a chance to perform, we will have three nights of open mic with about 10 participants in each session. There will be a sign-up sheet at our registration area, so look for it when you register. Please prepare & practice something vent related before you come and sign up.
